Ongoing Business

Budget and Vendor Update The budget spends are within 1% of targets, but there is a \$250 shortfall to date to cover the township's estimates on vendor fees. No new vendors have been added since May

New Park Event The recommendation to add, as an annual park event, a summer park party for the opening the water feature was rejected. In its place, Frank proposed two park events for children to build their parents a craft on the Saturdays before Mother's and Father's Day, May 13 and June 17. Both events will be budgeted for 2017, and Frank will chair the events.

Advertising Proposal Park Board Site Manager Joe O'Brien proposed that key park attractions (the basketball court, the hockey rink, the picnic area and the tennis courts) be made available for local company sponsorship. The board voted that Joe (as a township resident, since the Parks and Recreation board is not responsible for this) should take the recommendation to the Zoning board, and that any proposed signs are approved by the Parks and Recreation board.

Movies in the Park The board will vote on restarting Movies in the Park within the proposed \$2,400 budget allocated for the 3 showings. This will be discussed again at the July meeting.
