- Temporary Use Permits The Commission after discussion on the proposed ordinance recommended that the Supervisors consider the Ordinance for Adoption.
- 3. <u>Digital Display Ordinance</u> The Commission reviewed the proposed Ordinance with the added language proposed at their last meeting. The Commission recommended that the Supervisors consider adoption of the ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS - None

1. <u>825 E. Lancaster Avenue</u> - Present for the developer were Alyson Zarro, Esq., Jeff Bartos, Chris Varella, and Tom Kessler.

Discussion was held on the proposed ordinance to allow a townhouse development by conditional use in the OC-5 zoning district with a minimum of acres. The Commission discussed the overall development project, including the traffic pattern on Rt. 30 and the additional access that was acquired from Ashbridge Square to utilize a portion of their road way as an additional entrance and exit. The Commission recommended that the Board of Supervisors look favorably at the request.
